- Enrollment is limited. The Youth Leadership Pasco Selection Committee will review all applications and select up to 35 participants.
- Students who are interested in their community and who show a personal commitment to the Youth Leadership Pasco program goals and objectives will be given first priority.

Applications are due no later than September 9, 2019

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

Each participant must:

1. Complete the application material including required signatures.
2. Be responsible for any schoolwork that may be missed during scheduled activities.
3. Possess an excellent school attendance record.
4. Must participate in Orientation and Team Building on October 10, 2019 (mandatory attendance) and a minimum of three additional Youth Leadership sessions in order to graduate.
5. Students/parents are responsible for providing personal transportation to meeting sites.

No fees are required at the time of application. There is a \$35.00 tuition fee due by Oct. 2, if you are accepted into the program. Tuition fees may be waived upon request. If applicable, please include a letter with the application requesting the need for your fee to be waived.
